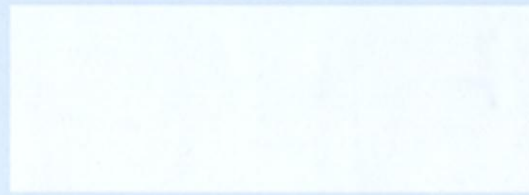



I wish to make a submission regarding PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY ISSUES.

We have a major cat issue in this town and I am presently targeting the feral/wild cat and kitten colony located at the former Waitomo District Council Building , former Te Wananga building, now vacant on the corner of Taupiri St.

I work at the Waitomo News and am frequently fielding calls from concerned members of the public regarding these apparently unwanted cats. As usual I always suggest they call the SPCA or Waitomo District Council. It appears that nothing is being done to reduce this growing population. I understand there is NO law regarding having un-speyed cats (not de-sexed) or how many are kept on a property as long as they are fed. These cats are continuing to breed and will never be homed and this is now becoming a major health problem as the numbers increase and the cats are wandering.

These cats are a public nuisance, given that the kittens wander across the road (safety issue) and one already has been run-over and killed while crossing the road looking for food. They are not fed on a regular basis, do not have warm adequate shelter, are not de-sexed, no vet check-ups and not cared for in a loving or responsible manner. They defecate on neighbouring properties (health issue) and the males spray marking their territory causing a disgusting odour. Cats are considered domestic and companion animals, these are not 'pets' but a colony of disease spreading animals, increasing in numbers, wild, untamed, living around a deserted building. They serve no useful purpose at all.

My Submission is: I would like to see regulations in place to give power to the council to regulate the number of cats on any given property as we do with dogs. Of course this will be almost impossible to police – but there is a difference between owning a few cats to several dozen, plus many more.

I won't even go down the 'track' of the many dozens of cats residing in the Cato/Craig Terrace area – but this is an example of out of control, non regulated breeding and in the long run is a becoming a major health issue.

2. Solid Waste Bylaw
