DECISION OF THE WAITOMO DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

1. The application for a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol pursuant to on-licence 19/ON/003/2020 authorising the sale and supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises is granted subject to the following conditions:
 - a) The temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through the principal entrance.
2. The temporary authority may issue immediately.
3. The temporary authority is granted for a maximum period of 3 months.

Reasons

1. This is the second application by Brothers 2022 Ltd for a temporary authority in respect of the premises situated at 1 Riverside Lane, Te Kuiti pending the issue of a new on-licence. Brothers 2022 Ltd has been operating under a temporary authority for the past three months. There is a current on-licence in force under the previous owner. Brothers 2022 Ltd has applied for a new on-licence and it is currently being processed.

Should the temporary authority be granted?

2. Section 136 provides that a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol can be granted to any person who has an interest in the premises where an on-licence is in

force for a period of up to 3 months. The purpose of this section is to give a new owner time to apply for a new on-licence. An on-licence was filed on 26 October 2022

3. The Liquor Licensing Inspector and Police have assessed the suitability of the applicant to hold a temporary authority and have no objection to the application. However, the Licensing Inspector has mentioned some concerns regarding alcohol litter around the premises and a lack of staff training records. The Inspector will address these matters with the applicant when the substantive on-licence is assessed.
4. The licensing committee is satisfied that Brothers 2022 Ltd has sufficient certificated Duty Managers to ensure compliance with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
5. The temporary authority is granted for a maximum period of 3 months pursuant to section 136(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 subject to the above condition and subject to the condition that the temporary authority must be displayed next to the base licence.
