### **Rates Rebate 2020/2021**

The Rates Rebate Scheme has been set up by the Government to help lower income households pay rates for the home they live in. The amount is based on your household income, number of dependents and your annual rates amount. This year the amount has increased to a maximum of \$655. To check eligibility, or to apply, visit our website or give our Team a call.

# What do my rates pay for?

Most of us use at least one service or facility every day that is paid for by rates. Roads, footpaths, drinking water, rubbish collection, parks or our library. They can make up a big part of our lives and we're committed to delivering these to our community every day.

You'll find a breakdown of what services and facilities your rates contribute to on the back of your rates bill.

### Paying rates

We have many ways to pay. Direct debit is a great option for anyone wanting to set, forget and avoid any penalties. To get set up, give us a call.

You can also pay by; internet banking, automatic payment, cheque, over the phone by debit or credit card. We also take cash, cheque or EFTPOS payments in person at our office or the Te Kuiti i-SITE.

# Having difficulty?

We know things may be tough for some. We're here to help and can work with you to set up a payment arrangement. We won't charge penalties and you can pay weekly, fortnightly or monthly, whatever works for you.

To support those impacted by COVID-19, the penalty charge on Instalment One has been reduced to 4%. The charge on remaining instalments is unchanged.
