IN THE MATTER of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

<u>AND</u> IN THE MATTER of an application by Kristin Louise Mischefski for a manager's certificate pursuant to section 219 of the Act

DECISION OF THE DISTRICT LICENSING COMMITTEE

- 1. The application for a manager's certificate is granted. The manager's certificate may issue immediately.
- 2. The manager's certificate shall continue in force until the close of the period of the day 12 months after the day it is issued.

REASONS

- 1. Kristin Louise Mischefski is currently working on a licensed premises and has applied for a manager's certificate. Although Kristen has only been working at a bottle store for a month, she has gained her experience in the alcohol industry from working at other licensed premises in the district. Kristin Louise Mischefski has held a Manager's certificate in the past.
- 2. The Liquor Licensing Inspector and Police have provided reports and do not oppose the application (s 220). Accordingly, this application is decided on the papers (s 202).
- 3. In considering an application for a manager's certificate the licensing committee must consider the following questions (s 222):
 - a) Is the applicant suitable to be a manager?
 - b) Have any convictions been recorded against the applicant?
 - c) Does the applicant have any recent experience in controlling any premises for which a licence was in force?
 - d) Has the applicant undertaken appropriate training and completed relevant qualifications under section 218?
 - d) Have the Inspector and Police raised any relevant matters in their reports?

Should the manager's certificate be granted?

4. The licensing committee is satisfied that Kristin Louise Mischefski is a suitable person to hold a manager's certificate because she has appropriate training, qualifications and experience and is of good character. Therefore, the manager's certificate is granted.
