

Waitomo District Library provides free computing and internet access via the Aotearoa People's Network Kaharoa (APNK).

FREE ACCESS TO APNK COMPUTERS

APNK laptop and desktop computers using the Chrome operating system are available in the libraries for customer use. A limit of 30 minutes per session applies (although users can extend this time if no one is waiting). When there are no computers available, a booking queue is available to allocate computers as they become free.

WHAT YOU CAN DO ON APNK COMPUTERS

For working with documents, Google Docs and Microsoft's Office Online are available, and require just a Google or Microsoft account to get started. The computers also have apps installed for video calling, screen recording, drawing, and many more. Each APNK device has USB ports (for attaching peripherals like flashdrives or webcams) and a headphones jack.



USE YOUR OWN DEVICE

APNK also provides a Free Wi-Fi network in the library during opening hours, which the public can access using personal devices such as laptops, smartphones and tablets.

PRINTING

A4 printing (in either colour or black and white) is available from APNK computers, at a small per-printed-side cost.

- Do anything illegal, infringe copyright or view offensive material
- Deliberately damage the computer hardware
- Disturb other people's use of the library
